Survey of all that part of the East 151 feet of Lot 27 that lies North of Interstate Highway 45 and the South 125 feet of the East 151 feet of Lot 28 in Section 1 of the Triable and Lindsey Survey of Galveston Island, Galveston County, Texas, more fully described by notes and bounds as follows: BEGINNING at the Northeast corner of said Lot 27 and the Southeast corner of said Lot 28; THENCE S 25° E, along the East line of said Lot 27, a distance of 205.50 feet to a point for corner in the North right of way line of said highway; THENCE S 30° 02' 01" V, along said highway right of way line, a distance of 22.93 feet to a point in a curve; THENCE Westerly, continuing along said highway right of way line and along the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 1136.28 feet, a distance of 144.74 feet to a point for corner which is 151 feet perpendicularly distant West of the East line of said Lot 27; THENCE N 25° V, parallel with and 151 feet West of the East line of said Lot 27, at 159.97 feet passing the North line of Lot 27 and the South line of Lot 28, a total distance of 284.97 feet to a point for corner; THENCE N 65° E, parallel with the South line of said Lot 28, a distance of 151 feet to a point for corner in the East line of said Lot 28; THENCE S 25° E, along the East line of said Lot 28, a distance of 125 feet to the place of beginning.
